Each walk is graded and the length stated. Please consider carefully before you agree to participate.

**One Boot:** Easy, Mostly flat and easy underfoot (paths/pavement) – usually 5 miles or less.

**Two Boots:** Moderate, Undulating, with some inclines; Rough underfoot - could be up to 7 miles.

**Three Boots:** Challenging, at least one steep incline/descent; Tougher underfoot - could be up to 7 miles.

**Four Boots:** Very Challenging, More than one steep incline/descent and/or one long steep incline/ descent; Tough underfoot – could be up to 10 miles.
