9th November 2011 Winchester Walk (Wednesday)



4.5 miles, 1 boot, level ground. A gentle walk, rich in history but also surprisingly rural, it follows the old Winchester canal past Abbey ruins, through the playing fields of Winchester College to the medieval Hospital of St Cross where we will take about half an hour exploring the ancient alms houses (£3.50 for seniors). We return via the River Itchen, the 14th century city gateway, and the cathedral close to reach the lunch venue, The Black Boy.

If sufficient interest it may be possible to organise a tour of Winchester College after lunch (£5.00 pp for seniors).

MEET: 10 for 10.15 The Broadway, Winchester at bus stops opposite the statue of Alfred the Great (south side). Post code SO23 9BE, map ref SU484293.

Parking (important). Recommended parking in the Chesil Street car park (£3.50 for 4 hours, £6 for more than 4 hours) about 5 minutes from walk start and lunch venue. On-street parking is available in Winchester but is very limited, usually short duration, and hard to find. There is also a park-and-ride. Details of parking will be sent to all attending the walk.

LUNCH: 12.45 – 13.00 The Black Boy, 1 Wharf Hill, Winchester SO23 9NQ. Renowned pub, good beer and food.

Non-walkers are welcome, probably best to use Chesil Street car park.

1st December Brooklands Museum (Thursday)

Brooklands – the world’s first purpose-built motor racing circuit – the birthplace of British motorsport and aviation, home of Concorde, and the site of many engineering and technological achievements throughout eight decades of the 20th century. There is an option of the **Brooklands Concorde Experience**, to see inside one of the world’s most famous aircraft and relive the excitement of the supersonic age. The 30 minute visit on board Concorde includes an exhibition in the rear cabin about how the aircraft was built and its connection with Brooklands. After passing through a display of Concorde interiors through the decades, you sit in the front cabin for a virtual flight. Visitors may see the Concorde Simulator in demonstration mode, subject to operational constraints. The **London Bus Museum** is now located on site and the entrance fee includes access.

MEET: 10.15 for 10.30 at Museum car park, KT13 0QN

DIRECTIONS: The Museum is between Weybridge and Byfleet, just a few minutes from Junction 10 of the M25 and the A3 London to Portsmouth. Leave the A3 at Painshill junction (A245) and follow the brown “Brooklands Museum” signs. **The main visitor entrance is via Brooklands Drive and Mercedes-Benz World, postcode KT13 0QN.**

COST: £9 senior citizens. Concorde flight experience optional, pay on the day £4.

LUNCH: 1pm in the museum, cost according to choice.

Each walk is graded and the length stated. Please consider carefully before you agree to participate.

One Boot: Easy, Mostly flat and easy underfoot (paths/pavement) – usually 5 miles or less.

Two Boots: Moderate, Undulating, with some inclines; Rough underfoot - could be up to 7 miles.

Three Boots: Challenging, at least one steep incline/descent; Tougher underfoot - could be up to 7 miles.

Four Boots: Very Challenging, More than one steep incline/descent and/or one long steep incline/ descent; Tough underfoot – could be up to 10 miles.
